Under this program, various schools of the country will get an opportunity to participate in SSC and witness the proceedings of DUSF'22xHMUNEA'23. This program is an attempt to invite participation from schools and reap maximum benefits out of young brains towards the environment.

The participants from the selected schools will get an opportunity to interact and get guided at more advanced levels from experts of University of Delhi, to better equip themselves for higher standards of education, emancipation and research.

CALL FOR PRESENTATIONS

The DUSF Secretariat invites Power Point Presentations (PPT) from School Students on the theme 'Youth and Sustainable Practices'

A team should consist of one teacher and not more than 4 students. Students only from Secondary and Senior Secondary (Class 9, 10, 11 & 12) are eligible to participate.

If you wish to submit a Power Point Presentation (PPT) for consideration, kindly follow the instructions outlined below:

- A team should consist of one mentor and 03-04 students. Students only from Secondary and Senior Secondary (Class 9, 10, 11 & 12) are eligible to participate.
- Each presentation should have a unique title, which is not a reiteration of the theme of the event, and must be prominently mentioned in the presentation.
- The Power Point Presentation should not have more than 25 slides.
- There should be proper mention of the sources if any Secondary Data is used in the presentation. The presentation must include a slide at the end that lists all the references used in the content.
- The judging process will primarily focus on creativity and innovation displayed in your presentation. Originality and unique perspectives will be highly valued in the evaluation.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding upon all the participants.
- A write-up (detailed explanation of the PPT and its content) not more than 500 words must be sent along with the PPT.
- The write-up must be sent in .pdf/.doc/.docx format, the title of the writeup/presentation, names of the teacher, students and the school must be mentioned.

No registrations and PPTs will be accepted after the due dates. The acceptance of the abstract shall be intimated through email to the registered participants by the DUSF- H-MUNEA Secretariat.

A maximum of 10 teams will be selected for Presentation in the conference. Each team will get 10 minutes to make their presentation followed by interjections of 05 minutes from the competing schools and judges.

Teams would have to arrange their own accommodation in Delhi. All the possible assistance will be provided by the DUSF x H-MUNEA Secretariat.

HOW TO APPLY

- The schools which wish to participate in School Students' Conference can register themselves directly on our website- www.harithkram.org by filling in the registration form. The presentation and write-up should be mailed to harithkram@sbs.du.ac.in with the subject of the email mentioned as DUSF School Students' Conference within the stipulated time frame mentioned below.
- A registration fee of INR 1500/- has to be submitted for the whole team after the Notification of Selected Presentations. The submission procedure will be communicated to all the selected participants via email. The fee paid is non-refundable and non-transferable.
- An authority letter from the head of the institution should be submitted at the time of registration at the registration desk on 06th October by all participants.

CALL FOR PAPERS

Harithkram- the Environment Society of Shaheed Bhagat Singh College invites research papers and posters from all interested young academicians and researchers at Young Scholars' Conference (YSC) on the focal theme "Youth For 'One Earth, One Future': Climate Change, Sustainability and Sustainable Practices." under the aegis of Delhi University Sustainability Forum to be held on October 06-08, 2023. YSC will provide a platform to young researchers, independent researchers and working professionals (with atleast 02 years of research experience) below 35 years who have keen interest in the field of Sustainable Development. There will be oral presentations as well as poster presentations in the conference. Interested author(s) are requested to submit the abstract according to the following guidelines: The Organizing Committee accepts submissions of original abstracts on any topic related to the theme. The abstract of the paper(s) submitted to the conference will be selected through peer reviewing process. Please read all instructions carefully before submission of the abstract.

Instructions for Submission of Abstracts

- The abstracts written in English should be submitted through E-mail at harithkram@sbs.du.ac.in Hard copy submission will not be accepted.
- Best 10 out of 20 selected papers will be presented as Oral Presentations. Rest of the 10 papers will be presented as Poster Presentations.
- Title: A brief title of not more than 15 words is recommended, and capitalization of the first letter of all major words. No abbreviations are to be used in titles.
- Author(s): The name should be typed in CAPITAL letters.
- Text: The abstract must clearly indicate the problem, methodology and result of the work in 300 words. (Abstracts above this limit will not be accepted). Subtitles, tables, symbols and diagrams must be strictly avoided in the abstract.
- Please include not more than 10 key words.
- All abstracts must be submitted by presenting authors along with his/her email address and contact number.

No Abstracts shall be accepted after the specified period of time.

The acceptance of the Selected Abstracts by the DUSF Secretariat shall be intimated through email to the registered participants.

If you need to re-edit your abstract, you may do so by contacting the DUSF Secretariat before the final deadline.

Participants would have to arrange their own accommodation in Delhi. All the possible assistance will be provided by the DUSF x H-MUNEA Secretariat.

- The scholars who wish to participate in Young Scholars' Conference can register themselves directly on our website- www.harithkram.org by filling up the registration form along with the abstract title and send the abstract on the mail harithkram@sbs.du.ac.in within the stipulated time frame mentioned below.
- A registration fee of INR 1000/- has to be submitted after the Notification of Selected Abstracts. The submission procedure will be communicated to all the selected participants via e-mail. The fee paid is non-refundable and non-transferable.
- An authority letter from the head of the college/department of the University should be submitted at the time of registration at the registration desk on 7th October by all participants.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTRIES

- Participation should be individual and each participant can submit only 2 images.
- Images of not more than 15 MB in size must be submitted online and the organiser may request for higher resolution images.
- Submitted images should be in JPEG format and at least 1,600 pixels wide for a horizontal image or 1,600 pixels tall for a vertical image.
- Digital manipulation that distorts the reality of the images will not be accepted. Only basic enhancements such as sharpening, contrast adjustment, or simple cropping will be allowed.
- Following details are required to be mentioned in the Google Form:
 - Captions / Description (Between 50-100 words relevant to the theme)
 - EXIF information of photographs (Shutter speed, Aperture, Focal Length, Camera Model, ISO)
- Top 50 entries will be notified and will be required to pay INR 100/- to be included in the exhibition and get qualified as the winning entries. The fee paid is non-refundable and non-transferable.
