

SCHOOL STUDENTS' CONFERENCE

ON

COVID-19 AND SDG-6

School Students' Conference is held under the aegis of DUSF, an initiative of Harithkram, Shaheed Bhagat Singh College, in order to create environmental awareness beyond the boundaries of the College and to channelise the potential of young school children towards a greener world through the medium of team efforts.

Under this program, various schools of the country will get an opportunity to participate in the SSC and witness the proceedings of **DUSF'20×HMUNEA'21**. This program is an attempt to provide young minds from schools with a conducive platform to voice their concern towards the environment in a competitive setup. The participants from the selected schools will get an opportunity to witness the proceedings of a University level Conference and interact with learned experts, which will equip them better for higher education and their role in the society.

CALL FOR PRESENTATIONS

The DUSF-HMUNEA Secretariat invites Power Point Presentations (PPT) from School Students on the theme 'COVID-19 and SDG-6.'

A team should consist of one teacher and 3 students. Students only from Secondary and Senior Secondary (Class 9, 10, 11 & 12) are eligible to participate.

Kindly follow the instructions outlined below to participate:

- Every presentation should have a **unique Title** (which should not be a copy of the theme of SSC).
- The Power Point Presentation should not have more than 25 slides.
- There should be a proper mention of the sources if Secondary Data is used in the presentation. The PPT must contain a slide at the end mentioning all the references.
- No registrations and PPTs will be accepted after the due dates. The acceptance of abstracts shall be intimated through email to the registered participants by the DUSF-HMUNEA Secretariat.

- The selected participants are expected to deliver their presentation over the **ZOOM Meetings** platform.
- The decisions of the judges will be final and binding.

The best 10 teams will be selected for Oral Presentation in the conference. Students shall be given a maximum of 10 minutes to present their Power Point Presentation, followed by interjections of 5 minutes from competing schools and judges.

HOW TO APPLY

- The students who wish to participate in School Students' Conference can register themselves directly on our website: www.harithkram.org by filling in the registration form. The notification for the confirmation will be sent shortly, following which the abstract should be mailed to harithkram@sbs.du.ac.in with the subject of the email mentioned as DUSF School Students' Conference Abstract. Upon confirmation of the abstract selection, the final presentation should also be sent on the same email with the subject DUSF School Students' Conference Presentation. All the correspondence should be completed within the stipulated time-frame as notified below.
- A registration fee of INR 100 per student (INR 300 per team) has to be submitted after the Notification of Abstract Selection. The submission procedure will be communicated to all the selected participants via email. The fee paid will be nontransferable and non-refundable.
